Suggested Route

Make it shorter by staying round the village centre or enjoy the full circuit!

Starting from the Information Kiosk, cross the river and walk up Sherborne Street to

1. Rose Cottage on your left.

2. Harrington House (G). Lovely garden at the back and a wonderful c.18 building.

Now, Pass the turning to Bow Lane on the left going to the right of The Warren and peep over the gate in the wall on your right, at the beautiful row of cottages with their small but lovely gardens and dove-cots. Sherborne Terrace. Sorry, no entry here.

Turn right into Pockhill Lane.

3. Summerhill View (G).

Now go back down Sherborne St. to Bow Lane on your right.

4. Grey Gables (G). Here as well as the beautiful garden, our local artist has her gallery/studio open, with her paintings, prints and cards on sale.

5. Bow Cottage (G). This lovely garden shows what can be done with a small area.

At the end of Bow Lane, turn right and cross the street into Clapton Row.

6. Lyncot (G) is on the corner to your right, sign on the stone wall.

7. Lincroft Stables (G).

Cross the river bridge and turn left to

8. The Painted House (G). Don't miss this, a wonderful hidden garden.

Turn right and follow Rissington Road to **9. Green Leigh.** A lovely garden worth the walk!

Now return to the centre and visit **St Lawrence's Church** where you will see a display of wonderful floral tributes for the Jubilee.

Carry on down Lansdowne and turn right into Mousetrap Lane

10. Lansdowne Cottage (G).

Go back to the church and walk up the pathway by it, passing the school and coming out at the top into Station Rd. Turn left and go on to Springvale on your right

11. Number 3, Springvale.

Go back along Station Rd. and turn right into Park Farm. Number 44 is at the end of the cul-de-sac on the left.

12. Number 44, Park Farm

Return to Station Rd and turn right. Go back along Station Road and Roman Way is on the left.

13. Number 56, Roman Way.

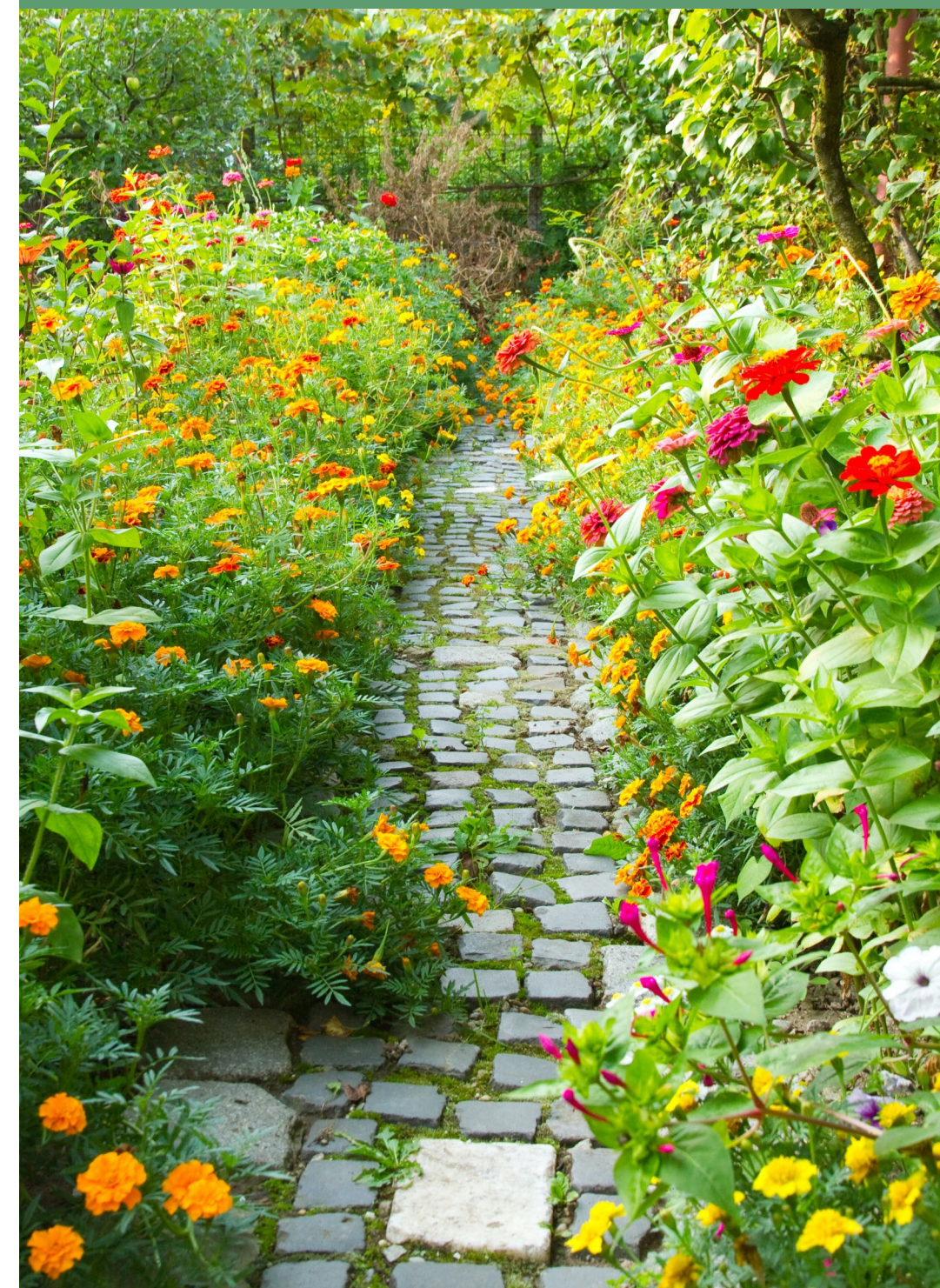
Go back to Station Rd and follow it turning left into the road leading to Greystones where on the right you can walk down through the **allotments** which are truly inspiring!
