**Council Meeting 9<sup>th</sup> January 2019**

**For Action:**

**GCC:**

Notification of public consultation on GCC's budget for 2019-20. The consultation runs until 5pm on 21st January 2019 and asks for people to comment on the council's budget priority areas and proposals. People can have their say via an online survey or by returning a hard copy survey, copies of which will be available in libraries and the county council main reception in Shire Hall. The budget includes investment of almost £11m into children's services as part of a £15m overall budget increase and sets aside £179m of new capital investment for schools, community facilities and highways, including funding for the council's £150m road improvements programme.
