



# Bourton on the Water Detached – April and May 2018

SUMMARY (from Gemma – Project Manager):

This year's detached work has gotten off to a good start. Key points drawn from session evaluations from Jack and Lou are;

- All of the young people that Jack and Lou have engaged with have been polite, tidy and respectful.
- Jack and Lou's presence in the village must have travelled along the grapevine as they have reported that the young people often introduce themselves to the youth workers first.
- Youth workers have had discussions with the PCSO who was out one night in their mobile van. This gave Jack and Lou some background information.
- Local residents have reported that they hadn't seen any young people hanging around or causing trouble.
- The leisure centre has reported that they haven't had any problems recently.
- Jack and Lou have shared parish council plans for youth provision with young people.

In the near future Jack and Lou are planning on advertising that they will be in a certain place at a certain time with a portable Wi-Fi device. Hopefully this will lead to young people being attracted to this area and give the youth workers the chance to engage with the young people in a positive way.

The times have been varied each week in order to cover some earlier periods and some later periods.
