**Minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held on 26 June at the George Moore Community Centre,
Moore Rd, Bourton on the Water**

1. Apologies for absence: Cllr Daniel, Cllr Sumner, Cllr Hicks and Cllr Randall.
2. Declarations of Interest. Cllr Hadley declared an interest in application 19/01917/FUL as a Governor of the school.
3. Minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held on 12 June 2019 were approved as a true record of the meeting and signed by the Chairman.
4. Matters arising from the minutes: It was noted that three organisations had bid for the old Co-op site. The tender period had now closed and a decision was awaited.
